	c. Hebrews 4:12 talks about the spiritual effect the Bible will have on an individual. In what ways has the Bible been "living" and "active" in your life?

- **5.** a. Do you ever find yourself believing something not because you have external evidence for it but simply because it is written in Scripture? Why or why not?
  - b. What makes you believe something in the Bible without needing external evidence?
  - c. How does trusting Scripture and obeying everything that it affirms lead us away from sin and into blessings of God in our life?
