2. Do you see yourself as an evangelist? Why or why not?

3. How often do you notice those on the fringes of society? In what ways are you compelled to help them or interact with them?

4. What role do the Scriptures play in the Eunuch's conversion?

5. Do you remember a time when the Lord compelled you to talk to someone about him? What happened?

6. How does this passage of Scripture affect the way you think about evangelism? Does it challenge you or encourage you?

7. This Eunuch was a man between cultures, he was neither a jew and would be on the fringes of many of our cultural debates. How does this story of Philip and the Eunuch instruct us on how we are to engage with those who aren't like us?
