PII Training



PII Training

Personally Identifiable Information

1. What counts as PII?

- Names, addresses, phone numbers, email addresses, etc
- Family details (spouse, kids)
- Attendance, prayer requests, or admin notes
- Anything that identifies someone personally

2. Why does protection of PII matter?

- Trust: People entrust us with sensitive details about their lives
- <u>Safety:</u> Mishandled data could put people at risk (e.g., scams, unwanted contact)
- Appropriate Use: This data has been collected for church-use only
- <u>Stewardship:</u> As leaders, we are accountable to God and each other to care for what's been

entrusted to us

3. Core Rules for Handling PII

- <u>Access only what you need.</u> Don't go looking at information for people outside your group, unless there's a church-related purpose for ministry work
- <u>Share wisely.</u> Never send group lists or personal info by group text, social media, or personal cloud accounts. Use only the church's approved database and tools.
- Protect access. Keep your login and password private. Don't let someone else log in for you.
- Store securely. If you download or print anything, treat it like cash: keep it safe.
- Do not leave it lying around where it is visible.
- <u>Destroy when no longer needed</u>.
- <u>Report issues</u>. If you lose a list, see suspicious activity, or accidentally share something, let us know right away.



4. Sharing PII with others

If Someone asks you for contact info of someone in your group, or at the church — what do you do?


→ Answer: "I can pass your information along to them, but I won't give out their contact information without their permission. Thank you for understanding."
